- 1) to be the main contact for the Club in dealing with any child protection issues or referrals from members or their families
- 2) to review from time to time the Club's child protection policies and procedures to ensure compliance with best practice standards and any LTA guidelines
- 3) to advise the committee on any actions or proposals necessary to improve or safeguard the Club's interests with regard to child protection issues
- 4) to attend periodically any courses relevant to child protection issues
- 5) to liaise with the coaching team and to advise them as required on child protection matters
- 6) to attend the committee meetings and to contribute to the running of the Club and to promote the objects of the Club as defined in the constitution
